- Students are required to mention their Name, Class, Section, Roll No and Subject, page number and date on each page of the answer sheet. Students will be responsible in case of any discrepancy arises regarding the name and other particulars.
- $\succ$  Students need not write the questions, but has to mention the correct question number.
